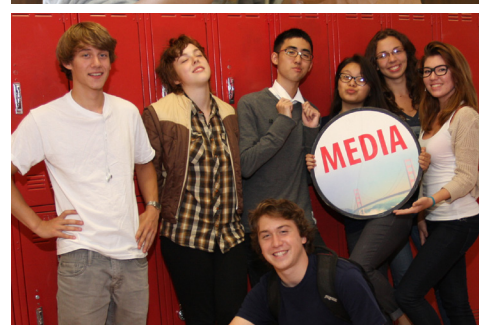

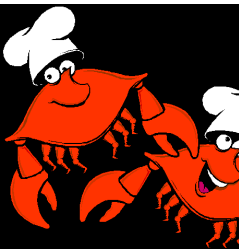
2010-11 Highlights of the Year



SOTA was named a **2011 California Distinguished School**. Schools were identified for eligibility on the basis of their Academic Performance Index and Adequate Yearly Progress results that are the state and federal accountability models, respectively. The schools selected are recognized for attaining high levels of performance and sustained growth, and for making significant progress in closing the academic achievement gap. SOTA was the only high school in San Francisco to receive the award in 2011.



SOTA collaborated with ECOSF and launched the **School Farm** next to the football field. A vibrant outdoor learning space was created and includes a food producing research farm with fruits, vegetables, herbs, native habitat, and urban livestock, on-site composting, greenhouse nursery operations, rainwater collection system, an outdoor classroom/kitchen powered by solar energy and small, functional examples of natural building techniques and appropriate technology from around the world.



The **Instrumental Music Department** held their 1st Annual Crab Feed Fundraiser and silent auction for over 300 hungry patrons. The sell out crowd feasted on all-you-could-eat dungeness crab, salad, noodles, and garlic bread while the SOTA musicians entertained and student waiters served the food.



The **Vocal Department** produced and sold copies of their first holiday CD, *Peace • Joy • Harmony*, raising over \$25,000 to fund a choral tour to Chicago. Fifty students journeyed to the Windy City during Spring Break and spent five days participating in master classes, collaborating with local high school choirs, visiting landmarks, and performing in public venues around Chicago.



The **Theatre Technology and Musical Theatre Departments** presented two fall musicals produced by Matthew Travisano and the late Dan Kryston — *The Adventures of Tom Sawyer* and *I Remember Mama*. The spring musical, *Ragtime*, was another successful, sold-out production that brought together a cast of over 40 SOTA students and several young actors from neighborhood elementary schools.

The SOTA **Theatre Department** presented Beth Henley's Pulitzer Prize-winning play, *Crimes of the Heart*. Originally staged in 1978, our production was directed by Ellen Koivisto and designed by Phillip I. Rayher.



SOTA Dance Department Advanced Dancers won 2nd place in the *Dance Under the Stars Choreography Festival* in Palm Desert, CA. The festival grew out of the need to provide emerging choreographers with support and opportunities to showcase their art. Choreographers and dancers from all over the country participated this exciting event!



PTSA presented the first **Alumni Night** by inviting SOTA alumni to share their stories with parents, students, and faculty. Ten illustrious SOTA alums that graduated between 1986 through 2009 came to speak and four others sent letters that were read aloud to the audience. It was an inspirational and unique evening for all!



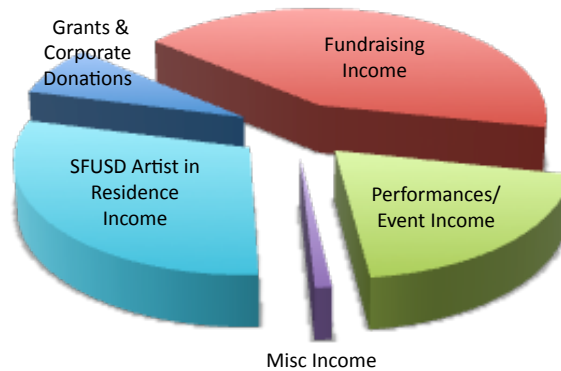
For the 2nd year in a row, **SOTA's Creative Writing** students won the San Francisco City Final in the national *Poetry Out Loud Contest*. National Endowment for the Arts and the Poetry Foundation partnered with state arts agencies to support *Poetry Out Loud*, which encourages the nation's youth to learn about great poetry through memorization and recitation. This program helps students master public speaking skills, build self-confidence, and learn about their literary heritage.



Principal Sgarlato traveled to the People's Republic of China to learn more about Chinese culture and language. Primarily, the focus was to exchange ideas with Chinese educators and visit schools to begin a dialogue about teaching and learning in the two countries. The trip was sponsored by the Chinese government through the Hanban/Confucius Institute and covered all cost except for the travel fare. The agenda was filled with presentations, travel to cultural sites of importance, school visits and ample sampling of Chinese cuisine.

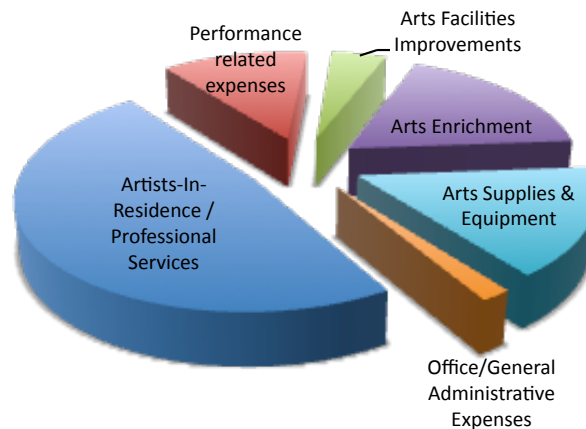
